Ps 96:1-2a, 2b-3, 4-5; Mt 23:13-22 Mary's queenship has roots in Scripture. At the Annunciation, Gabriel announced that Mary's Son would receive the throne of David and rule forever. At the Visitation, Elizabeth calls Mary "mother of my Lord." As in all the mysteries of Mary's life, Mary

is closely associated with Jesus: Her queenship is a share in Jesus' kingship.

#### Tuesday Saint Rose of Lima, Virgin



2 Thes 2:1-3a, 14-17; Ps 96:10, 11-12, 13; Mt 23:23-26 Historians remember St. Rose of Lima for her piety and chastity. She was exceptionally beautiful . When she turned 20, she was permitted to join the

Third Order of St. Dominic. She continued a life of extreme prayer, fasting and penance. On one occasion she burned her hands as a self-imposed act of penance. She was known to wear a heavy silver crown, with spikes that could pierce her flesh. The spikes reminded her of the Crown of Thorns.

One of the Twelve Apostles of Jesus, he has been identified with Nathanael (who appears in the Gospel according to John as being introduced to Christ by Philip .He was flayed alive and crucified,

#### Thursday St. Louis; St. Joseph Calasanz 1 Cor 1:1-9;



Ps 145:2-3, 4-5, 6-7; Mt 24:42-51 Reigning from 1226 to 1270, Louis IX showed how a saint would act on the throne of France. He was a lovable personality, a kind husband, a father of

eleven children, and at the same time a strict ascetic. St. Louis was a member of the Third Order of St. Francis and so is included in the family of

Franciscan saints.

Joseph's works of charity were for the instruction of neglected and homeless children, many of whom had lost their parents. Joseph joined a Confraternity of Christian Doctrine and gathered the boys

and girls from the streets and brought them to school. He opened the first public free school in Europe.
