



HOPE IN FLINT DAY – SEPTEMBER 10



Deacons from around the Diocese of Lansing are gathering at St. Mary's Church in Flint for a day of hope. St. Mary's is located in the northeast side of Flint and there is a push being made to reach out to the local community; to let them know the church is present and available to serve, pray, and be for them. The day will consist of adoration, reconciliation, food, games for children, and walking the neighborhood "two by two."
